


# FEATURE ARTIST SHOW

## CERAMICS PAGE



I love wearing this quirky fun pin — I can't wait for the day I run into someone who has it on as well :)





I offer four different workshops. These are booked on an as-requested basis, so if you are interested, just contact me to set up a time that works for both of us!



















#### YOU TUBE CHANNEL
